Women around the world face great danger giving birth. With the help of a legacy donation, IN UK were able to fund the construction of a maternity unit in Bobo Dioulasso, Burkina Faso.

Nine years on, it's thriving as a self-sustaining centre, supporting over **8,000 safe births** to date and providing **care for over 60,000 women**. Fati is one of the women who has benefitted from perinatal care at this facility. Here she reflects on the holistic support she received:

“After safely giving birth to my first baby, I was given an insecticide-treated mosquito net from the maternity centre. I am so relieved and grateful that I can protect my baby from mosquitoes and malaria.”
